MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of St Paul's Art on the Parish Green is to showcase fine art and fine craft of the highest quality, to connect artists with the art-buying community, and promote to our commitment to the arts through a variety of arts experiences.

GENERAL INFORMATION

St Paul's Art on the Parish Green is a two day showcase of visual arts and fine craft. Additional activities during Art on the Parish Green include live performing art activities and a children's art activities tent. Outdoor booth spaces of 10' x 10' will be available. Your booth may be on grass or pavement. Corner weights for the outdoor booths are highly recommended. A limited number of indoor spaces are available in the Carriage House; however these spaces are irregular in shape and are smaller than 10 x 10. For the indoor spaces, all displays must be contained within the marked lines.

PUBLICITY

A postcard will be produced and distributed throughout the Kentuckiana area. Cards will be available to participating artists to send to your customers. Numerous avenues of publicity will advertise the art show.

BOOTH REQUIREMENTS

Show tents are recommended for the booths, but not required. The appearance of your booth is essential to promote your work and enhance the overall appearance of the show. Remember the sides and back of another booth will be visible in your booth.

All tables must be skirted to the floor or ground. Nothing may be attached to any walls or windows. Some outdoor electricity will be available on a first come first served basis. Please bring your own heavy duty extension cords. Two artists may share a booth, but must jury separately and both must be accepted.

INSURANCE AND SALES TAX

Each artist is responsible for obtaining his or her own insurance. Neither St Paul's Episcopal Church nor any representative of the parish will be responsible for any losses or damage to any work exhibited or property brought to the Art Show. Each artist will be responsible for paying sales tax to the state of Indiana.

REFRESHMENTS

Exhibitors will be offered complimentary coffee and pastries one hour prior to opening on Saturday.

SECURITY

Security will be provided throughout the night from set up to tear down.

HOW TO APPLY

Artists must submit separate applications even if they plan on sharing a booth. Those artists who want to exhibit in multiple categories must apply separately in each category and those artists whose work is accepted in multiple categories must exhibit in only one booth space. Only those mediums that have been accepted may be shown.

DIGITAL PHOTOS

A total of 3 photos (4" x 6" prints or 300dpi digital images on a cd) are required representative of the work to be shown at the show. Only digital images of your art will be considered for use in advertising on postcards, brochures, TV ads and the art show website. We will select from the digital images of artists accepted into the show. By submitting your images, you are giving the art committee permission to use images of your work on art show advertising.

ACCEPTANCE

Upon acceptance notification, the booth fee of \$75.00 will be deposited. Cancellations must be in writing and postmarked by April 1st. . A \$25 cancellation fee will be charged. After April 1st there will be no refunds.

Sunday June 3rd : Booths are open 11:00a.m - 5pm.

MEDIA CATAGORIES

CERAMICS: No mass produced works
DIGITAL ART: Work must be in limited editions, signed and numbered by the artist.

DRAWING

GLASS: No mass produced work
GRAPHICS AND PRINTMAKING
JEWELRY: Original jewelry in any material

METALWORKS: No production works

MIXED MEDIA: Original 2 and 3 dimensional work which incorporated more than one type of material

PAINTING

PHOTOGRAPHY: Original prints. Digital photography falls into this category unless the image has been manipulated by the artist, in which case it is entered in Digital Art.

SCULPTURE: Original sculptural work in any media.

WOOD: Original work in wood, hand-tooled, machine-worked, turned or carved.
